Arrival and Dismissal Policy 2019-2020

Welcome back! Please note our school hours are 8:20 am to 2:40 pm.

Arrivals

Students should be in the building and with their classes prior to the start time. Students arriving after the start time in either building are recorded as tardy. Students should understand the importance of regular and punctual attendance. Breakfast is served to each child for free at 7:50 am. Children will wait with their classmates in the auditorium until the start time when they line up to go to their classrooms.

Dismissals

At dismissal, every student will exit the building with his or her class at the designated door. It is the responsibility for the parents to make sure their children are picked up on time. Our staff members are not available to watch your child after dismissal. If you will have trouble picking up your child on time, there is an **afterschool program** available for a fee, **Ultimate Enrichment** at 718-681-1187. Please contact the parent coordinator for any other information.

We stagger dismissal at the main building for families with children in different grades.

Grades K-3: All students are dismissed face-to-face with a parent/guardian or adult designated on the blue card **ON TIME** every day. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure all adults picking up their children know the dismissal time and are on time every day. Siblings who are in middle or high school **must be on time** at PS 94 for pick up.

Grade 3 & 4: Children in grades 3 & 4 **may** walk home from school **if** a parent sends in written permission. Please send the attached note in immediately to your child's teacher. Any 3rd or 4th grader without this letter on file will not be allowed to walk home and must have someone pick them up at dismissal.

Grade 5: All students are dismissed to walk home. If a parent wishes to pick up their child they must be at the dismissal door on time. Grade 5 will not be brought back into the building.

Bus: If you would like to receive bus service you must fill out a form. You may request a form from your child's teacher or download it on our website. If your child qualifies for bus service please inform the teacher in writing whenever your child will NOT be riding the bus home. Please do not ask your child to "tell the teacher" not to place them on the bus at the end of the day. If a note is not received your child will be placed on the bus. Children will be escorted from their classrooms to the yellow bus. Please make sure you are at the bus stop on time.

Drivers: Please allow extra time to get to the building, park your car and walk the dismissal area. Please do not double park. It is dangerous not only for you and your child but to other children and adults as well. Do not park in front either of our building. These are spots reserved for our busses and we must have them available to get our students on and off the busses safely. Consider walking your child to and from school if possible. This will avoid looking for parking and being late to pick up.

Meal Programs:

Breakfast: Breakfast is available for all students **free of charge**. Students who eat breakfast should arrive at 7:50 am. This will give them plenty of time to eat breakfast before school begins. All students must be back in the meeting area before the start of the day.

Lunch: Hot lunch is available to all students **free of charge**. Each family must also complete a School Meal eligibility form online at www.myschoolapps.com/Application. You must complete this form whether you wish to receive school lunch or not.

School Security

All parents/guardians and visitors **MUST** sign the "Sign-in Book" at the security desk. **ALL visitors are required to show photo I.D.** The school safety officer will then direct everyone to the main office. No parent may go directly to his or her child's classroom without first checking in at the main office.

School closings

School closings will be written into monthly calendar sent home, our school website calendar as well as the yearly calendar on the DOE website. We will also send reminders. The city rarely closes NYC schools but in case of inclement weather please listen to the local news reports or sign up for "Notify NYC" to have school closings sent to you email or phone.
