PARENT SAFETY PLEDGE

"I value the preservation of life above all else."

When I am in the car, I pledge:

- To buckle up
- To observe all traffic rules (i.e. No U-Turns, Double Parking, Speeding, Going around school bus when "stop" sign is out, etc.)
- To drop off my child/children at school in a safe manner, not double parking, not letting them out of the car in the middle of the street. I will also not leave my car unattended in a NO STANDING zone.
- Not to be distracted by anything that will make me take my eyes off the road
- Not to text while driving
- Not to talk on the phone-If I have to talk, pull over to the side of the road, talk only with a wireless headset
- Make eye contact with those crossing the corner and use extra caution during inclement weather

When I am walking, I pledge:

- To always cross the street at the crosswalk
- Not cross between parked cars or school busses
- Not to text and carelessly walk across the street
- Not to talk on the phone and carelessly walk across the street

ABOVE ALL:

- Set a good example to my child/children and others when walking or driving.
- Continuously educate my child/children and others about traffic safety and traffic awareness when walking or when driving.
- Be respectful to Traffic Agent/Crossing Guard's/School Officials/ Safety Agents instructions.

STUDENT SAFETY PLEDGE

When I am in a car, I pledge to:

- Buckle my seatbelt
- Ride quietly in my seat
- Wait until the car comes to a complete stop before opening the door
- Exit the car on the non-traffic side
- Offer to hold or turn off the driver's cell phone, or take a message, if asked.
- Remind drivers to keep the promise they made to always put safety first while driving.

When I am walking, I pledge to:

- Only cross at the corners and when the "Walk" sign is lit
- Look both ways before I cross the street
- Never cross between parked cars or school buses
- Make eye contact with the drivers to make sure they see me
- Not use my cell phone while crossing the street
- Not stop to talk or play in the middle of the street
